## 2016-2017 School Uniform/Dress Policy & Supply List

### CASUAL DRESS GUIDELINES

TEQ Sombrillo Elementary is a casual dress school. No baggy or sagging pants will be allowed. No oversized sweatshirts or jackets will be allowed. No tight fitting jeans will be allowed. Shorts and skirts are allowed but must not be more than 2 inches above the knee. If you have any questions regarding our dress code policy please contact the school.

#### Pants

No sagging or baggy pants

No long belts

Shorts and skirts must be no more than 2 inches above the knee.

#### Shirts

No mid-drift shirts or spaghetti straps
