STUDENT DRESS CODE

A uniformly dress code encourages students to express their individuality through personality and academic achievements, not outward appearances. The following is the uniformly dress code for Abiquiu Elementary.

*Tops/Shirts

- Must be collared
- Any color either solid or stripes are permitted
- No letterings or designs
- Must have sleeves, no muscle shirts, tank tops or spaghetti straps.

*Bottoms

- Pants, any color, with pockets, (**no leggings, gym shorts or sweatpants**)
- Denim is allowed
- Skirts, dresses or shorts must be longer than fingertip length when hands are at sides

*Other Dress Code Rules

- Long belts are not allowed
- Clothing must fit properly, not overly tight or overly baggy
- Underwear **must not** show through clothing or be visible at any time
- Clothing cannot be ripped or torn and the midriff must be covered at all times
- Large facial piercings are strongly discouraged
- Students cannot wear open toed shoes and flip flops

***Students who do not follow dress codes rules will be asked to change and/or parents will be called to bring a change of clothes. Student discipline policy will be followed.**
